

RULES AND INFORMATION

Captain's Meeting: Friday September 11, 2026 - 6 PM - 8:30 PM

Tournament: Saturday, September 12, 2026 - 6 AM - 3:30 PM

Weigh-In: 2 PM – 3:30 PM Dinner, Awards, Raffles Immediately Following



By voluntarily participating in this tournament, each angler agrees to abide by the following rules. All decisions made by the TACCA-GSA Fishing Tournament Committee will be final

Weigh Master determines the eligibility of all fish and may disqualify any fish that is deemed illegal, not fresh or has been tampered with

1. **Check-In:** One Team member must check in team on Friday Captain's Meeting - Mandatory
2. **Official Start Time:** 6:00 a.m. - there will be NO pre-fishing check-in the morning of the event
3. **Weigh-In:** Weigh-in will be held at The Waterline at Doc's, 13309 S. Padre Island Dr Corpus Christi, TX 78418
4. **Weigh-In time is 2:00 – 3:30 PM** One team member must be in line with all fish by 3:30P or the team will be disqualified Ice Chest will be tagged at check-in and may only contain fish to be weighed in **NO EXCEPTIONS**
 - a. Your team fish must be decided for all categories before getting in line for the Weigh Master
Combining fish between teams or boats is not permitted and is cause for disqualification of both teams
5. **Teams:** There are no divisions in this tournament. All teams compete against each other
 - a. Maximum 4 anglers per boat. If guide fish (i.e., sets hooks) they are considered anglers, count towards maximum number of anglers, and must pay an entry fee, except that Junior anglers are free
6. **NEW for 2026 Junior Division** (16 & under): Each junior division fish entry will be weighed separately for Junior Division awards and may also be included in Team Stringer weigh-in and team awards
7. **Fishing:** This is a rod & reel tournament. All baits are allowed if it meets Texas Parks & Wildlife regulations
 - a. Anglers are encouraged to wear life jackets while large motor is turned on
 - b. This is a bay tournament. Fishing outside of jetties is not allowed, Texas Parks and Wildlife rules apply
8. **Categories:**
 - a. Heavy Team Stringer: Max - 2 Trout (15-20"), 2 Redfish (20"-28")
 - b. Heavy Trout: (15-20") **MAY NOT be part of stringer**
 - c. Heavy Redfish (20-28") **MAY NOT be part of stringer**
 - d. In the event of a tie for Heavy Trout & Heavy Red Prize will be split
 - e. Awards given for Heavy Stringer - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th & 8th – **EVERYONE ENCOURAGED TO WEIGH-IN**
9. **Cash Pots:** Each pot is \$20 per team- **Stringer and/or heavy fish MAY NOT be used for cash pots**
 - Spot Pot** 20 –28" Redfish with the most spots
 - Black Drum Pot** (14-30") – Length drawn Friday night, closest to length without going over wins
 - In the event of a tie Cash Pots Prize will be split
